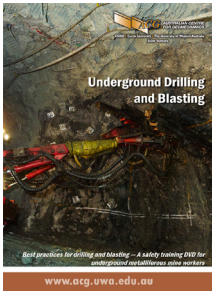

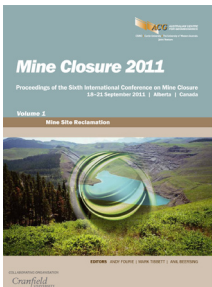


Fourth International Seminar on Strategic versus Tactical Approaches in Mining

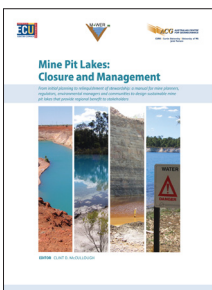


Sixth International Conference on Mine Closure

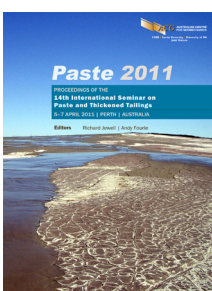


Mine Pit Lakes:
